

## **EXCHANGE STUDENTS @SCHOOL OF PSYCHOLOGY: HOW TO CHOOSE COURSES**



- 2) Exchange students are free to choose course units from every 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle degree course (=Bachelor and Master) of the School of Psychology.
  - If you're a Bachelor student and you're interested in some of our Master course units just read the syllabus in order to check if you meet the prerequisites in order to take them
  - If you're a Master student and you're interested in some of our Bachelor course units, just take into account that some topics may be too easy for your background
  - we do not offer doctoral courses for credits: PhD students are allowed to take courses from 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle degrees and are asked to agree a thesis/project research with one of the professors teaching in our doctoral school. - 3) There are two degree courses whose course units are entirely held in English: *Psychological Science* (=BPS) and *Cognitive Neuroscience and Clinical Neurpsychology* (=CN2). Just pay attention to course units belonging to these degree courses: exchange students need to ask for the authorisation to attend the course(s) of interest directly to the professor(s) by writing him/her/them an e-mail. Usually exchange students are allowed to take these modules but as BPS and CN2 are very selective degree courses, professors should know in advance how many extra students they have to deal with.

Please note that <u>you don't have to ask for the authorisation before filling in your Learning Agreement</u> but you have to do it at a later stage. Prepare your L.A. and upload it on our Application Form platform. After your submission, during the L.A. evaluation process, these courses will be marked as "OK". When we will send the L.A. back to you signed and stamped, we'll just remind you to ask for the authorisation.

- 4) You're allowed to choose course units from our on-line Bachelor *Scienze e tecniche Psicologiche*. We'll explain you how to sign up to these course units during the Welcome Meeting of the School
- 5) Timetables won't clash If you choose courses from the same year of the same degree course
- 6) Erasmus Incoming students are <u>not allowed</u> to choose 2, 3 and 5 CFU (=ECTS credits) course units held at the School of Psychology (*Abilità informatiche*, *Lingua inglese per la psicologia*, *Computer skills*, *Academic English*, all seminars/labs belonging to 2nd cycle degree courses)
- 7) If you choose a 12 CFU <u>corso integrato</u> (=integrated course) it is <u>compulsory</u> to take both units. You can't "split" the course and take only one module: the final mark is given only by attending both modules and sitting both exams.



- 8) You're allowed to choose course units also from other Schools/Departments but in this case we're not responsible for any specific restriction for exchange students. For information about other Schools' course units, please refer to the International Office in charge.
