STUDY PLANS

General rules

As a student you **must** fill in a Study Plan at https://uniweb.unipd.it

Enrollment in Academic year 2022/2023

If you are a student having enrolled in the Academic year 2022/2023 you should fill in your Study Plan for the whole three-year duration of the degree course (in case of first cycle degree courses, BA's) or for the whole two-year duration of your degree course (in case of second cycle degree courses, MSc).

First cycle degree students (BA's)

If you are a first cycle degree student (BA's), you should fill in your Study Plan with all the course units/activities included in the 'Outline for a Study Plan' (*Manifesto*).

However, when you enroll in the first year, you will be able to take only the course units/activities listed in the first year. Instead, when you will enroll in the second year, you will be able to take course units/activities listed both in the second and in the third year.

Second cycle degree students (MSc)

If you are a second cycle degree student (MSc), you should fill in your Study Plan with all the course units/activities included in the 'Outline for a Study Plan' (*Manifesto*), and you can anticipate the activities of your second year.

Enrollment in previous Academic years

If you are a student having enrolled in previous Academic years, you should fill in your Study Plan only with the course units and/or activities foreseen for the current year.

Submission Periods

You should submit your Study Plan **only** during the following periods:

Automatically accepted Study Plan: from 03/10/2022 to 30/06/2023

Study Plan to be approved: from 15/10/2022 to 15/11/2022 and from 15/03/2023 to 15/04/2023

Type of Study Plans

You could choose between two types of Study Plans:

- Automatically accepted Study Plan
- Study Plan to be approved

Automatically accepted Study Plan

If you choose the *Automatically accepted Study Plan*, you will have to select your optional course units **only** among those of the current year belonging to the School of Psychology Degree courses.

Please note also that you must check if further restrictions are present in the 'Outline for a Study Plan' (*Manifesto*) of your Degree course.

Once you have completed your Study Plan, you must press on "CONFERMA PIANO" (Confirm Study Plan) and it will be automatically approved.

You are not required to print the Study Plan.

If you should find your Study Plan has not been loaded or is not correct, please contact pianidistudio.psicologia@unipd.it.

Study Plan to be approved

If you choose the *Study Plan to be approved*, you could select your optional course units not only among the course units belonging to the Degree courses of the School of Psychology but **also between those of other Degree courses**.

Once you have completed your Study Plan, you must press on "CONFERMA PIANO" (Confirm Study Plan) and it will be automatically delivered to the Chair of the Degree course or to the professor in charge of evaluating it for the approval, exclusively during the previously mentioned submission periods. You will be responsible for checking whether the correct Study Plan has been loaded in your online track before exam sessions start.

If you should find your Study Plan has not been loaded or is not correct, please contact pianidistudio.psicologia@unipd.it.

Please note also that:

- You cannot take an exam if you have not submitted your Study Plan and/or it has not been approved yet
- You should fill in the Study Plan only with the optional course units worth the number of credits allowed by the 'Outline for a Study Plan' (*Manifesto*) of your Degree course
- Once you submit the application to take the graduation exam (esame di laurea), you will not be allowed to make any change to your Study Plan.
